DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

New London Academy continues in operation on its original (1796-1798) site, approximately one mile to the west of the village of New London on the old Lynchburg-Salem Turnpike (Route 297). The campus includes the eighteenand-one-half acre tract deeded to the original Academy Trustees by prominent residents of the New London community. Ten acres of this -- the Robert Alexander grant -- reverts to the grantee's heirs or assigns should the academy cease to function as a school.

The earliest buildings consisted of "a handsome and commodious academy, a president's house, and a large brick church well enclosed." Of the related outbuildings, an early frame kitchen with central chimney survives and presently serves as the academy museum. The Academy Presbyterian Church, built (1856-57) across the roadway from the school, replaced the earlier structure. By 1839, the original "commodious academy", or frame « classroom-dormitory building, had been replaced by one of brick.

This <u>circa</u> 1837-39 building has been continued in use, in varying capacities, to the present day. Window enlargements and other evolutionary changes have affected the original three-bay symmetry of the old academy, however the basic block with its interior end chimneys, low hipped roof and Flemish bond brickwork remains. This building and the old kitchen symbolize the historic continuity of New London Academy, and provide a contrast to the dominant, post-World War II campus-style structures.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Persons familiar with the history of schooling in Virginia will recognize in New London Academy a microcosm of that history from the Jeffersonian period to the present. In December of 1795, the General Assembly granted a charter to incorporate the Academy. The following year (reaffirmed in 1828) the Assembly authorized the Trustees to "raise by lottery, a sum of money for the use of the New London Academy." The Virginia Literature Lottery was an important source of revenue for Virginia's schools during this period, a time when lotteries were used to support internal improvements and other public purposes.

New London Academy was established on its present campus <u>circa</u> 1797 as a classical school for boys. It retained this character throughout the ante-bellum era although certain modifications in curricula were introduced. During this period, the Academy "was one of the most useful in the State. Its reputation was very high." This, the opinion of a prominent historian of education, finds ample support among such learned contemporaries as Francis Walker Gilmer. New London, according to Gilmer, provided an education comparable to that available at the better American colleges.

The older social and educational philosophy of Virginia could not survive Appomattox. During the 1870's, New London became a co-educational institution, and added an elementary department. By the latter 1880's it was affiliated with the new public school system. At the turn of the century teacher-training courses were conducted at the Academy and in 1910 New London became one of the first of the new District Agricultural High Schools. The 130-year long tradition of boarding students at the academy gave way in 1929 before increasing costs and improved transportation. School consolidation and integration affected the Academy during the 1960's and the high school division was removed from New London in 1964.

The Academy's legal status is unique. It is the only public school in Virginia to Operate under a charter from the General Assembly. Its Board of Managers, by authority of the Code of Virginia, retains "control and management of the estate and administration of said New London Academy." In addition to all other powers conferred or confirmed by the General Assembly, this Board (successor to the original Board of Trustees) is "vested with all the rights, power and authority now or hereafter conferred by law upon county school boards."

New London Academy has survived since 1795 by adapting itself to the changing circumstances, educational philosophy and needs of the Commonwealth. It was founded as a community school by, and for, prominent families. It remains a community school in the democratic usage of the twentieth century.
