2. Windows:

a. Original house: Wooden double-hung windows have nine-over-nine lights and are surrounded by a wide architrave trim. The gabled dormers have six-over-six lights.

b. Later house: Both the upper and lower windows have double-hung windows with six-over-six lights.

G. Roof:

- l. Original house: The steeply pitched roof has a slight kick at the eaves. Two dormers open on the west slope and one on the east slope.
- 2. Later house: A shallow gable roof has pedimented ends, and a modified Doric cornice with mutule and guttae surrounds the pediment and roof.

III. Description of the Interior

A. Floor plan:

- l. Original house: The rectangular house is divided into four unequal rooms with the entrance in the larger southwest room.
- 2. Later house: Typical of temple-form houses, this structure has a lateral front hall with two large rooms behind.

B. Stairways:

- l. Original house: The original single-run stair is now located near the east door and has square newels molded handrail and turned balusters. A later narrow spiral stair ascends in a corner of the northwest room.
- 2. Later house: A two run open-string rectangular stair with balusters ascends in the northwest corner of the hall.
- C. Wall and ceiling finish: Most of the plaster walls are papered, although some are painted. Ceilings are painted plaster.
 - D. Doorways and doors:
- 1. Original house: Architrave trim surrounds six-paneled doors
- 2. Later house: Symmetrically molded trim has corner blocks with rosettes. The wide soffits are paneled, as are the doors.

E. Trim:

- l. Original house: A typical late-eighteenth century chair rail with symmetrical molding is in all the rooms. The southwest room features a dentil cornice with crown and bed moldings.
- 2. Later house: The lower rooms have a very simple molded cornice.

F. Heating:

1. Original house: Although this house was originally heated by fireplaces, it now shares a central heating

system with the later house. The southwest room features an elaborate chimneypiece with a paneled breast framed by fluted pilasters. The mantel in the northwest room has a wide shelf with moldings, a band of interlocking geometric molding in the frieze and pilasters.

2. Later house: The mantels here feature wide shelves, central panels with ellipses and columns. Diagonal reeding is utilized on the friezes and shelves.

IV. Site:

- A. General setting and orientation: Oak Hill is set on a hill facing west to the Blue Ridge and is surrounded by rolling pastured hills.
- B. Outbuildings: A line of outbuildings, including a three-bay kitchen with brick exterior end chimneys, a log smoke house and a three-bay slave quarters with one exterior end chimney, is located east of the main houses. Several barns and other farm outbuildings are situated farther east of this row.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Oak Hill was the country seat of Chief Justice John Marshall and the place where he spent much of his young adult life. The original portion of the estate's interesting two-section house survives as a rare example of a Fauquier County Colonial farmhouse, and the later adjoining building is a simple but dignified late-Federal dwelling. The architectural interest of both structures is heightened by the fact that nearly all of their original finely-detailed interior woodwork is intact.

The Marshall family became established in the vicinity when Colonel Thomas Marshall, father of the Chief Justice, moved from nearby Germantown, Fauquier County, and settled on a farm on Goose Creek near the village of Markham in 1765. In 1773 he bought the nearby Oak Hill tract and built a seven-room frame house there. This house is the older portion of the Oak Hill complex. John Marshall lived permanently at Oak Hill from the time of its construction until his marriage in 1783. Thomas Marshall gave Oak Hill to his son in 1785 when he decided to move to Kentucky, and, although he lived mostly in Richmond and Washington after his marriage, Marshall maintained an active interest in his county home.

During his tenure Marshall enlarged and improved the In 1819 he had erected the temple-form Federal house adjoining the older dwelling as a residence for his son, Thomas. Following the deaths of both John Marshall and his son in 1835. Oak Hill became the property of Thomas's son, John. At Oak Hill John Marshall II lived the life of "a scholar and literary gentleman," while maintaining a generous and hospitable house. His generous ways proved too costly and he was forced to sell Oak Hill to his younger brother, Thomas. Thomas Marshall, a colonel in the Confederate Army, was killed in action in 1864, and Oak Hill was sold out of the Marshall family. In the late nineteenth century Oak Hill was owned by F. W. Maddux. son sold the estate in 1914 to Mr. and Mrs. Alvin Baird. 1965 Oak Hill was acquired by Morris Marks who maintains it as a working farm.
