STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			

The land on which the present Brownsville farm is located was included in a 1262 acre tract, patented in 1652 by John Browne. The property was inherited by Browne's daughter Sara, wife of Arthur Upshur, and has remained in the hands of their descendants to the present day, making it one of the oldest family holdings in Virginia. The first building known to have been built on the tract was a small frame dwelling, 25' x 35', with a brick dated 1691. This house, which was known as "Brownsville Old Hall," was originally located a short distance to the east of the present house, but in 1898 it was moved across the creek and is now in ruins.

The present brick house was built in 1806 by John Upshur at the relatively high cost of \$10,000. Because of the many relatives who shared his new house, Upshur declared, "There is no place to put the sole of my foot," so in 1809 he added the one-and-a-half story frame wing. The main part of Brownsville is an unusually carefully built structure, constructed of materials of the highest quality. The interior woodwork is considered to rank among the most sophisticated and elaborate Federal woodwork on the Eastern Shore. Many of the details are similar to those of woodwork found in other important houses on the Shore such as Kerr Place, Wharton Place, Eyre Hall, and Wesley. It would seem that these examples, as well as others, were executed by a single talented craftsman who unfortunately has not been identified. Despite the anonymity of Brownsville's designer and builder, the house stands as a distinguished homestead for one of the Eastern Shore's oldest families.
