Site is that of a palisaded Indian village of the Late Woodland Period, with older components also present. The site is farmed, except for a narrow strip through the site for [REDACTED] leading to Quicksburg, [REDACTED]

Test excavations in the portion of the site lying [REDACTED] produced postmolds of a palisade and of circular houses. Numerous pits dug for food storage or for graves were also found.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Quicksburg Site is one of the few sites known which contains evidence which might eventually identify the Indians who lived in the Shenandoah Valley in prehistoric times.

Since nothing is known of these Indians, and since ^{such} ~~are~~ sites are scarce, it is essential that this site and the few others known, be so identified and marked that they will be preserved for posterity and for more intensive study by archeologists of the future. If any construction is to take place in the site area, a full archeological study should be required.
