STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

St. James Church was built in 1838 from materials salvaged from an earlier eighteenth century church nearby. This may account for the early appearance of the side elevations. While the exterior of the church is interesting, the chief significance of the building lies in the fact that it has retained its nineteenth century painted architectural decoration on the interior. All that is known of this decoration is that it was done shortly after the church was built by a traveling artist named Potts. Although other churches in the United States may have had this type of ante bellum decoration, St. James is an extremely fine, if not unique example. It is interesting and indeed unusual that a church of such provincial architectural quality should contain such sophisticated and finely executed decoration. That the artist was able to work his design so successfully into the existing fabric is a testament to his skill.
