DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Kerr Place is a two-story Federal mansion with a central projecting pedimented pavilion on both the front and rear elevations. The brickwork is even colored Flemish bond above the molded water table and English bond below. Rubbed brick splayed arches appear over all the windows, and a rubbed brick frame encircles the round window in each pediment. At the base of the gable roof and around the pediments is a Federal-style bracketed cornice. There was, at one time, a glassed-in cupola at the junction of the cross gable, but it burned in the early-twentieth century and was not replaced. On the eastern end of the building is a two-story wing which originally was a one-and-a-half story kitchen connected to the house by a hyphen.

The first floor plan of Kerr Place includes a central entrance hall behind which is a reception room. Flanking these two rooms is a drawing room on the west and a dining room on the east. The staircase is located in the entrance hall. The interior trim in the principal rooms is probably the most elaborate and formal found in any house on Virginia's Eastern Shore. Especially notable is that of the drawing room which includes fine examples of Wellford molded and applied decoration in both the cornice and mantel. According to Ralph Whitelaw, there is a tradition that the drawing room walls were covered with French block-print paper, "Telemaque dans 1'Ile de Calypso," by Joseph Dufour. Apparently most of the doors in the house were painted to imitate wood grain and inlay, as one undisturbed example survives on the second floor. Except for some new partitions in two of the bedrooms, the interior of Kerr Place survives essentially as built.

In 1793 John Shepherd Ker acquired 364 acres of land, inherited by his wife, the daughter of George Corbin, in the vicinity of the present town of Onancock. It generally is assumed that Ker did not begin construction of his house until 1799 "when he established the reversion interest in the land in his name" and probably was completed by the time of his death in 1806. Although the house is now called Kerr Place, the family signed their name Ker, and the house was referred to as Ker's Place in John Ker's will of 1806.

In 1875 the house and seven acres were sold to George W. Powell, a member of Powell Brothers, merchants and maritime agents. It was Powell who added a glassed-in cupola on the roof so that he could watch his ships sailing in and out of Onancock Creek. Following Powell's death, the house passed through several owners until 1960 when the house and two acres of land were acquired by, and made the headquarters of, the Eastern Shore of Virginia Historical Society.

Kerr Place survives as probably the finest and most elaborate Federal mansion on Virginia's Eastern Shore. The architectural kinship between it and several other Federal houses in the area, such as Brownsville and Wharton Place, indicate a common architect-builder who unfortunately has not been identified. It is appropriate that one of the Shore's major architectural landmarks should become the headquarters of a society dedicated to the study and preservation of the Eastern Shore's historical heritage.
