

Located at the north end of the parking lot of the First Baptist Church, 2932 King of Alexandria, the city in Virginia, Southwest No. 3 Mile Marker is among the painted physically located This is the first stone parking places. in Virginia to be placed at other than Since the end of the mile equal miles. was in a ravine this marker is located slightly less than three miles from the South Corner. The top and edges are

chipped and consequently some of the original inscription is missing. Part of it reads M 302p to indicate 2 miles 302 poles. The current measurements are 12" X 11" X 19". Placed 23 June 1917, the 3' X 3' X 5'4" wrought iron fence is painted silver. There is no plaque. The property is owned by the First Baptist Church, whose trustees gave permission for the current survey. The stone was surveyed 25 October 1989, by Mrs. Martin P. Fish of Captain John Smith Chapter, VADAR, in Arlington, VA.
