#### ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

This structure is an interesting example of Flemish architecture expressed with the great curving Jacobean gables. This feature, while not being extraordinary, is the only example in the city. Other features of the exterior are typical of commercial structures dating from the first quarter of this century; ie. segmentel and jack arches, center pavilion with the company's monogram over the entrance, and small, decorative quoins done in brick.

## HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

The lot was purchased by the J. S. Young Company in 1916 from Alvin J. Street who had acquired the property from the Charlottesville Land Company. The Young Company held title to the land until 1938, when it was sold to Howard Y. Haffner. The present owner's family bought the property in 1939. ACDB 97-352, City DB 97-141, 98-138, City WB 7-152.

SIGNIFICANCE

The Young Building is unique in that it is the only example of the Jacobean Revival style in Charlottesville.
