

Summary Paragraph

Clifton Forge owes its existence to three simultaneously occurring events in the surrounding environs: the selling of the original land grant in 1825, the creation of the Lexington and Covington Turnpike in 1826, and the establishment of both the Longdale Furnace and the Clifton Forge in 1827; all involving Scots-Irish immigrants. These events created enough activity to warrant the opening of a "Clifton Forge" post office in 1830 near the western entrance to Iron Gate Gorge.¹ Located in the Town of Clifton Forge, in Alleghany County, Virginia, the Clifton Forge Residential Historic District occupies 174 acres of the Town's original 1890 plat map. The town developed as a direct result of the 1890 consolidation of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway's shop facilities on the Jackson River about one mile west of downtown. Although Clifton Forge was created to serve the railroad as an important terminal, shop location, and division point, it was first established as Williamson's with the arrival of the Virginia Central Railroad in the mid-1800s. With the consolidation of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway, the town developed along the north slope of the Jackson River. The streets are well defined with houses aligned among regular setbacks, concrete sidewalks, and mature shade trees. The streets range from a wide boulevard displaying the largest houses and churches to narrow streets packed with worker housing. The district retains spatial relationships and streetscapes dating to early twentieth century patterns of racial segregation with both the historically white and black neighborhoods boasting their own residential, religious, and educational buildings. The majority of resources are single-family frame vernacular dwellings dating to the turn-of-thetwentieth century, augmented by architect-designed churches and schools, as well as rowhouses, apartment buildings, a park, cemetery, and an armory. Vernacular Queen Anne-style houses are predominant followed by Bungalow and Colonial Revival-style houses. Most of the secondary resources are 1920s frame garages, frame or brick garages with second floor single dwellings, and sheds. The district is dense with architectural resources built on the 1890 grid pattern with negligible modern infill. The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District includes 730 contributing resources and 32 non-contributing resources spanning the period of 1890 to 1950.

Period of Significance (justification)

In the area of Black Ethnic Heritage (Criterion A), Community Planning and Development, and Architecture (Criterion C), the period of significance for the district extends from 1890, the consolidation of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway shops in Clifton Forge, to 1950, when the shops began to relocate to Huntington, West Virginia, and construction practically ceased.

Statement of Significance Summary Paragraph (provide a summary paragraph that includes level of significance and applicable criteria)

The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District is significant under Criteria A and C in the areas of Black Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Architecture. Clifton Forge owes its existence and character to the establishment of rail yards and terminal facilities by the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway in 1890. Important resources within the district date from 1890, representing the consolidation of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway shops in Clifton Forge, to 1950 when the shops began to relocate to Huntington, West Virginia and residential as well as commercial construction rapidly declined in Clifton Forge. The proposed boundaries feature the core concentration of housing that is associated with the period of growth and prosperity of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway. Houses within the proposed district generally possess a high level of integrity, and represent a number of domestic types that are primarily vernacular in character. A collection of architectdesigned buildings illustrates the work of well-known architectural firms such as Frye & Chesterman, Heard & Caldwell, and George Washington Kramer. The numerous churches and schools in the district comprise important examples of early-twentieth-century architecture, and several are associated with the African American community. The African American Jefferson High School is individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Identified as VDHR ID 105-0171, the 1926, Colonial Revival-style school is listed under Criterion A for Education and Ethnic Heritage. The district illustrates the topographical constraints of town planning and development in this mountainous region. The land along Smith Creek, a notable physical feature in the district, was set-aside for industrial use in the 1890 plat map, and began to be developed in the 1920s for civic use, featuring the Clifton Forge High School, Public Playground (now Memorial Park), and later the Armory. The Town's first cemetery, Crown Hill, is also included in the historic district.

Narrative Statement of Significance (provide at least one paragraph for each area of significance)

The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District is eligible for listing in the National Register under Criteria A and C at the local level in the areas of Black Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Architecture for the period of 1890 to 1950.

The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District is eligible for listing under Criterion A for Black Ethnic Heritage for its African American community that was established in the earliest part of town, perhaps first with the early iron industry, and then later as workers on the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway. The black community in the historic district contains its own businesses, schools (vacant), and churches, with a wealth of residential architecture. The Jefferson High School (105-0171) is the only resource within the historic district, as well as in Clifton Forge, that is individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District is eligible for listing under Criterion C for Community Planning and Development for its collection of residential, religious, and educational buildings that represent the creation

of a railroad town after the 1890 consolidation of the Chesapeake & Ohio (C&O) Railway repair shops in Clifton Forge. The new town was built according to the 1890 Clifton Forge Plat Map that laid out the streets in a grid pattern that followed the steep slopes, terraces, and creeks along the north bank of the Jackson River. The Plat Map includes a reserved area along Smith Creek that was dedicated to industrial development (with a C&O spur line), and land that was later developed for a high school, a playground, and an armory.

The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District is also eligible for listing under Criterion C in the area of Architecture for its historic architectural qualities. The 174-acre district includes a rich and diverse collection of late nineteenth- and early twentieth-century residential, civic, and religious architecture that fully conveys the setting and feeling of a railroad town. The district includes styles that range from vernacular worker housing and I-houses to high-end Gothic and Colonial Revival and Queen Anne styles. Representative works span from the local builder Andrew Jackson Acord to well-known architectural firms such as Frye & Chesterman and George Washington Kramer. All but three percent of the resources remain contributing along the platted streetscapes.

Narrative Description

The Town of Clifton Forge lies in the high valley between the Shenandoah and Allegheny ranges in the "panhandle" of Alleghany County in southwestern Virginia. Positioned between Bath County to the north and Botetourt County to the south, the town is surrounded by the George Washington National Forest amid the terraces and steep slopes above the north bank of the Jackson River. Many creeks flow through town to the Jackson River, but the banks of Smith Creek, which bisects the historic district, were reserved for open, industrial use. The town is located three miles above the Jackson's confluence with the Cowpasture River to form the James River. U.S. Route 60 (the former Lexington to Covington Turnpike) travels east to west through downtown, and U.S. Route 220 enters the east end of the district over the Jackson River.

The mountainous terrain of the region supported only sparse settlement and limited agriculture in the early to mid-nineteenth century. Prior to the coming of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway (C&O) in the late nineteenth century, much of the surrounding region was valued only for its mineral resources. Iron-making was undertaken from the earliest period of settlement in Alleghany County, and included an early nineteenth-century iron furnace near what would become Clifton Forge. However, the Town of Clifton Forge developed only after the C&O located shops and terminal facilities there in 1890.

Clifton Forge is a late nineteenth century railroad town that reflects the platting and architecture styles characteristic of such towns. Despite the rough terrain, the original layout of the town in 1890 followed a grid pattern, which was the most efficient means of surveying and dividing land for settlement. The C&O shops and yards occupy the Jackson River flats as well as later infill along the river. The yards run east to west along the river, and the early street grids were oriented to the railroad tracks. Later development extended the grid north, east, and west, often resulting in steeply sloping avenues and odd junctions at creek crossings. Residential construction fills the streets that rise north of the central business district. The domestic architecture of Clifton Forge reflects the railroad-related expansion between the 1890s and World War II, characterized by densely constructed frame dwellings for skilled railroad workers. Developers and their contractors erected clusters of housing, often blocks at a time, to accommodate the influx of new homeowners, thereby producing homogenous housing styles and scales. The builders' choice of a detached frame dwelling with a yard in the back and a porch in the front spoke to the rural heritage of the new occupants.²

The earliest surviving houses in the district date to the beginning of the building boom associated with the C&O and reflect traditional house forms with restrained Queen Anne-style detailing. These earliest examples remain on the primary streets of Main, Church, and Pine Streets that are closest to downtown. By 1900, new vernacular house forms were being built, such as the two-story, symmetrical three-bay, single-pile, frame house with a side-gable roof, end-chimneys, and a central-hall plan. An excellent example of perhaps one of the earliest houses is the ca. 1892 I-house at 912 Main Street (VDHR ID 105-0198) that features original weatherboard siding (while all other houses are clad with a mass-produced milled wood siding), stone piers infilled with brick, and a rare exterior-end brick chimney.

Referred to as the I-house, in urban settings this popular building form throughout the South, as well as in Clifton Forge, was generally built for businessmen and professionals. Some of these vernacular I-houses took on strong Queen Anne Style characteristics with intersecting gables, bracketed cornices, and porches highlighted with flat-sawn balustrades and spindlework.

Local builder, Andrew Jackson Acord, who owned a lumberyard and planing mill (105-0186) on the C&O spur line along Smith Creek, constructed many houses during the 1890s. Many of the decorative trim pieces that adorn the houses can be attributed to him. As Clifton Forge grew and prospered in the early 1900s, saw and planing mills expanded their production not only of framing members and flooring, but also of exterior doors and windows, and decorative trim to suit every taste. A good example of a 1890s vernacular T-shaped frame house dressed with bay windows and milled trim is the L. F. Alley House at 600 Pine Street (105-0165). With increased house production came more builders and contractors, which coincided with the influx of architectural pattern books and catalogs that offered stock designs of every shape and size. The irregular massing of the vernacular Queen Anne-style houses and trim broke up the uniformity created by the dense cluster of worker houses. Rows of the two-story frame houses were built along the hillside parcels of Brussels and Keswick streets, and closer to town along Church Street.³

McCormick Boulevard was the address of many business professionals and some of the railroad's upper management (most railroad management lived in West Clifton Forge). Running north through the middle of the town, the street features some of the largest homes of the wealthiest citizens at the turn of the twentieth century. Much like Patterson Avenue in Roanoke's Southwest Historic District, developed for the Norfolk & Western Railway executives, McCormick Boulevard is the widest street in Clifton Forge, flanked by sidewalks, mature shade trees, and high-style houses on the largest lots. Along with high-style architect-designed churches, some of the best examples of domestic Queen Anne, Neo-Classical Revival, Colonial Revival, and Bungalow/Craftsman styles are found on this street. In 1911, local businessman A.O. Surber built the well-known landmark, Hillcrest (105-0042) at the summit of the steep McCormick Boulevard. This large Neo-Classical-style brick house overlooks the town from its highest vantage point on its largest residential parcel. Hillcrest also features a two-story, three-bay, brick garage with living quarters on the second floor, with access from the rear elevation.

Many strong examples of frame and brick garages that the Sanborn Insurance maps depict along alleyways of middle class residences in the 1920s remain intact, along with unique examples of barns, domestic/office buildings, servants quarters, and a carriage house. A prevalance of coal sheds also remain. Most of the secondary resources remain unmodified, although vacant, with wood siding and metal-clad gable or hipped roofs. Some Colonial Revival brick houses have matching brick garages, as well as some frame Bungalow/Craftsman and Dutch Colonial style houses have matching frame garages. While most garages in the historic district are one-story, McCormick Boulevard features a predominance of two-story, square-massed garages with a second-floor living space, most presumably for servants. Several strong examples of secondary resources include the servant quarters located at the C. P. Nair House at 600 Church Street (105-0152), a barn, and a domestic building serving the A. N. McCullen House at 700 Church Street (105-0151), the brick Colonial

Revival garage associated with Hillcrest (105-0042), and the frame Arts-and-Crafts-style garage associated with 720 Commercial Avenue (105-0107).

In addition to the prevalence of detached single-family dwellings, rental facilities such as duplexes, boarding houses, and other types of apartment buildings were provided for the influx of railroad workers at the beginning of the twentieth century. Many rental units are located on Brussels Avenue, which parallels Rose Run, a tributary to the Jackson River. One distinctive example is The Stalls (105-5036-0053), a two-story frame building of eight rental units built under one long roof. A continuous, metal clad, hipped-roof porch with wood columns shelters the façade; each three-bay unit is separated by porch railings. Built in 1922, the building was later covered with bricktex siding to mimic a higher quality brick construction material. Many duplexes remain throughout Clifton Forge, and two other good examples include an unadorned version at 800 Brussels Avenue (105-0078) and a Colonial Revival duplex at 817 Church Street (105-0173).

During the 1920s and the 1930s, the nationally popular Bungalow/Craftsman and Colonial Revival styles were the chosen styles of middle class residential neighborhoods in Clifton Forge. Their designs were popular in pattern books and their building materials were accessible by railroad delivery. These styles featured affordable, yet artistic designs. One such example is the frame, middle-class Bungalow/Craftsman-style C. W. Revercomb House at 1029 McCormick Boulevard (105-0044). In fact, all classes of residents chose these two styles in varying degrees of design and detail. The working class chose the simpler frame bungalow cottage design, while the upper class chose the Colonial Revival designs with brick veneers, large front porches, wings, and bracketed eaves. An excellent example is a brick American Foursquare with matching garage is the Grubbs House at 120 Church Street (105-0076).

By the early twentieth century, mail-order catalogs of house plans could be purchased and shipped directly to the builder's site by rail or truck. Thus, Clifton Forge benefitted from its close association to the railroad. Companies such as Sears, Roebuck & Co. and Aladdin Houses produced pre-packaged "kit" houses for the then-popular Bungalow and American Foursquare house types. Many strong, potential examples of kit houses remain intact in the historic district, particularly on prominent street corners. One such example is the Bungalow/Craftsman house at 617 McCormick Blvd. (105-5036-0339) that matches "The Princeville" example from a 1919 Sears catalog. The W. F. Andrews House (105-0069) at 501 Clay Street matches the rarely used Dutch Colonial Revival plan from the Sears "Modern Home No. 137" example. A modest Colonial Revival example is "The Alden" built in 1940 at 620 Commercial Avenue.⁴

A unique example of a probable Sears kit home is the prominently displayed Queen Anne-style E. F. Scott House at 900 Church Street (105-0149). According to Sanborn Insurance maps, the house was constructed between 1917 and 1921. The Scott House overlooks the corner of Church and B streets in the African-American section, and displays such Queen Anne-style characteristics as hard-fired brick, wood shingles, turrets, porches, and rough-faced cast-concrete details; the house matches "Modern Home #303" from the rare 1909 Sears catalog. Oak doors, trim and woodwork were included, and the house was designed to be built of

solid brick. The house was built for prominent African American businessman Edmund F. Scott, and remains with his family today.⁵

The historically African American area of Clifton Forge, on the eastern edge of town, primarily follows the oldest streets of Main, Church and Pine Streets (intersected by A, B, and C Streets) with frame houses--from modest worker housing to large two-story houses, to frame and brick schools, and high-style brick churches. This African American community, like the adjacent white community, featured businessmen and professionals. Two physicians lived and practiced here by the early twentieth century. Dr. Edward T. Conner lived at 921 Main Street (105-0176) in a large Queen Anne style house on a prominent corner lot. Conner practiced medicine in this house for more than 50 years. Local tradition states that his family practice included both black and white residents. Less is known about Dr. S. G. Gibbs who lived on Church Street in the 1920s and practiced out of the former 1902 'Colored School' located at 1011 Church Street (105-0170).⁶

The one-story, five-room, brick veneered 'Colored School' building with a metal clad hipped-roof near the top of Church Street remains intact, although vacant. In 1926, and one block west, the larger, red-brick, two-story, Jefferson High School (105-0171; NRHP-listed) was built in the Colonial Revival style. It served the black community until 1965, when the school system was integrated, and the students had to attend the formerly all-white Clifton Forge High School. Jefferson High School than served as Clifton Forge Elementary East, but permanently closed in 2001, when all Alleghany County schools were consolidated at Low Moor, a small, formerly mining community, west of Clifton Forge in Alleghany County.⁷

Churches played a vital and early role, in historically black communities such as in Clifton Forge. Originally located on the south bank of the Jackson River, the black community moved north across the river by the 1890s and established three churches. The ca. 1892 frame First Baptist Church remains on Church Street, albeit now with a brick veneer. The church was built on land donated by E. F. Scott. The frame building conformed to the gable-front, twin-corner tower design popular for African-American churches. The other principal black church in Clifton Forge, Main Street Baptist Church, located at the eastern entrance to the district, is a distinguished Gothic Revival-style building that was built in 1921 after replacing the original 1885 frame church. The 1885 frame church was built for the white Clifton Forge Baptist Church but was later sold to the black Baptists when the east side of the town became predominantly African American.⁸

During the early 1880s, in addition to the original 1885 Baptist Church that stood at the east end of town, all Christian congregations were held in a simple frame building on Main Street. By 1886, however, the Presbyterians, Methodists, and Christians all had chosen Church Street sites on which to build. The Methodist Church was dedicated at 612 Church Street (105-5036-0109) in 1885 and served until 1910 when the congregation outgrew the facility. The temple-form building became a boarding house and finally apartments.⁹

By the early 1900s, all of the largest churches in the segregated white community had erected larger facilities that were designed by out-of-town architects. In 1906, the First Christian Church built a Gothic Revival-style church (105-0056) at the corner of Church Street and McCormick Boulevard that was designed by the New

York City architect George Washington Kramer. The Presbyterians hired the architectural firm Frye & Chesterman of Lynchburg for their 1907 Mission/Spanish Colonial Revival-style church and the Baptists used the firm for their 1907 Queen Anne Parsonage. The Presbyterian Church (105-0014) overlooks the corner of Jefferson Avenue and Church Street with a buff-colored brick veneer (a Frye & Chesterman trademark). The Presbyterian Manse is located across the street at 428 Jefferson Avenue (105-0138) and stands as an excellent, intact example of Queen Anne-style architecture along with its brick carriage house.

The 1908-1910 Gothic Revival-style Methodist Church was designed by Covington architect Sidney Pace. In 1912, the Clifton Forge Baptist Church (105-1053) on McCormick Boulevard, commissioned the Lynchburg firm of Heard & Caldwell to design its church and Sunday school wing. Saint Joseph's Catholic Church (105-0139), like the black First Baptist Church on Church Street, began as a frame church that was later brick veneered. The church has a steeply-pitched front-gable with a skewed corner tower that was originally used for its entrance. Located close by at 616 Jefferson Avenue, Saint Joseph's was constructed in 1889 and brick veneered by 1927. Its rectory, located next door at 620 Jefferson Avenue (105-0140) is a good example of ca. 1900 Queen Anne-style architecture, and is physically connected to the church site via stone steps and a wall.

During the 1920s, major civic architectural projects were undertaken. An open space in the middle of town and adjacent to Smith Creek was left undeveloped for civic use as specified in the 1890 plat map. Lynchburg and Roanoke architect Clarence Hinnant designed the 1928 two-story Colonial Revival-style Clifton Forge High School (105-0068). The large, red-brick school featured a cafeteria, gymnasium, auditorium, and a community ball-field, although the contemporaneous 1927 African American Jefferson School did not. At this time, the town's white population also attended the 1907 Clifton Forge Elementary School, now known as Moody School (105-0161), a large Neo-Classical building at Pine and Jefferson streets. Although the Moody School serves a new use, the Clifton Forge High School is vacant.

Built in view of the Clifton Forge High School, the 1940-1941 Clifton Forge Armory (105-0067) served the 29th Light Infantry Division of the Virginia National Guard. Funded by the town, state, and the Federal Work Projects Administration, the two-story brick building is partially used, yet viable for a new use. In 1928, the City Playground officially opened in conjunction with the Clifton Forge High School; it featured a ball field with a grandstand, in which different baseball teams, such as one from the C&O, played. In 1945 it was renamed Memorial Park, the Town's first public park. The park then expanded to include a swimming pool, which eventually closed in the 1950s. The park remains open with a ball field.¹⁰

A variety of social and fraternal organizations were established in Clifton Forge around the turn-of-the-20thcentury. Most were held in second floor rooms above downtown stores. Although most were white, African American men had established a Central Hall and Scott's Hall in frame buildings on the east side town, while African American women had formed a City Sunshine Club; it is not known where and/or if these buildings are standing. Within the historic district is the Clifton Forge Woman's Club, located at 717 Commercial Avenue in a one-story, 1939 Colonial Revival brick building (105-0190). The building housed the town's only lending library until the permanent library was built in 1975. The club was an outgrowth of "The Mutual Improvement

Club," which was founded in 1903, and met in two rooms over the old First National Bank building on Main Street. The original purpose of the organization was self-improvement, but later expanded to "the promotion of ideal conditions in the community."¹¹ Also within the historic district, is the second Masonic Lodge building, a non-contributing 1961 brick veneered building located at 725 Commercial Avenue (105-5036-0203).

Although three cemeteries serve Clifton Forge, only the earliest cemetery, Crown Hill, is located within the historic district. In 1897, after years of population growth, the first burial plots were for sale at Crown Hill. Still rural by nature, the Town Council stipulated that the unused areas of the cemetery be rented out as pastureland. The cemetery, with its parallel rows of headstones, rests upon a hill overlooking the Jackson River, at the eastern entrance to the town. The older granite and marble headstones generally represent the nationally popular designs of the turn-of-the-twentieth century. In 1964, the Rainbow Mountain Garden Club beautified the cemetery's corner at A and Main streets and its curvilnear entrance along A Street.

Industrial development within the Town of Clifton Forge was limited in part because of the dominance of the C&O. As all rail lines did, the C&O encouraged the development of manufacturing in order to promote freight traffic. Located within the historic district, a C&O spurline had been laid from the rail yards along the river north beside the west bank of Smith Creek, a corridor that had been dedicated to industrial development in the 1890 plat map. However, these industries could not compete with the main line and many were short-lived. But many vital companies were established along this corridor, including the Clifton Forge Electric Light and Water Company that built an electric power plant at Smith Creek and Pine Street in 1888. The construction of this power plant made Clifton Forge one of the first towns in Virginia to have a municipal electrical light service although it was initially limited to larger public buildings and street lighting. In 1913, the company was reorganized as the Virginia-Western Power Company, and in 1928, was sold to the Virginia Public Service Company.¹² The tall, one-story, gable-fronted brick building (105-0070) then served as the Clifton Forge Steam Laundry though the 1960s, servicing private households, businesses, and professional offices. The building is currently vacant.

Within the historic district and north of the electric power plant (the Clifton Forge Steam Laundry [105-0070]), the Standard Oil Company of New Jersey once established a small complex, adjacent to the Clifton Forge Coal Company to the south. Primarily a tank and storage facility, the complex served Standard Oil, which held extensive operations in the coal region of Virginia and West Virginia. Remnants of the C&O spurline tracks are still evident along both sites, although no extant buildings remain. By 1892, Andrew Jackson Acord, the town's first building contractor, strategically established the A.J. Acord Saw and Planing Mill on the north side of Church Street between Smith Creek and the C&O spur line. Bought by G.K. Anderson in 1897, the mill was sold to the Alleghany Construction Company in 1907, who expanded the operations with a lumber yard, sheds, and warehouses, some of which remain. ¹³ The 1907 warehouse at 518 Church Street (105-0186) was added onto in 1921 with a long, one-story brick building fronting Church Street. The building later became a tire dealership, and now houses the Clifton Forge School of The Arts.

The above-mentioned, 1888 Clifton Forge Electric Light and Water Company/Clifton Forge Steam Laundry building (105-0070), the ca. 1892 A.J. Acord Saw and Planing Mill/Clifton Forge School of The Arts building (105-0186), and a ca. 1927 abandoned, two-story, frame warehouse at 604 Commercial Avenue (105-5036-0183), are the only three commercial/industrial buildings recorded in the historic district.

The flurry of the 1890s boom town had played out by the late 1920s, and the Great Depresion and World War II delayed construction in town, whether civic, residential, or commercial. Further, the C&O rail yard, which had employed 2,000 workers until 1950, began the conversion from steam powered locomotives to diesel, which resulted in reduced employment and the eventual closing of the rail yard shops.¹⁴ The Clifton Forge Residential Historic District maintains a high degree of integrity and cohesion, with three percent non-contributing resources. While modifications have occurred to individual resources, there is minimal post-1950 construction. The importance of Clifton Forge is not evident in individually significant buildings, but in the collection of largely vernacular properties that maintain the scale, lay-out, and feeling of a turn-of-the-twentieth century railroad town in the Alleghany Mountains of southwestern Virginia.

Inventory of Resources

Properties in the Clifton Forge Residential Historic District inventory are organized alphabetically by street, and numerically by address. If known, the historic name of the property is included, followed by the Virginia Department of Historic Resources resource inventory number and resource types of all resources on the property. Abbreviations of contributing status include the letters NC (non-contributing) or C (contributing). Buildings identified as contributing are those constructed within the period of significance for the district, 1890-1950, that have retained most of their integrity as historic buildings. Buildings identified as non-contributing were either of more recent construction or have been altered to such an extent that they lack minimum integrity required to fall within an area of significance. Construction dates are based on field observation, Sanborn Insurance Maps, and local tax records.

Developmental history/additional historic context information

The area that would become Clifton Forge was part of two land grants given to Robert Gallaspy (Gillespie) in 1770 and in 1772 by Lord Botetourt, the Governor of Virginia. The roughly 200-acre tracts covered the flatbottom land on the north side of the Jackson River and on both sides of Mill Creek, now known as Smith Creek. The ownership of the land changed several times, until it was sold in 1825 to Henry Smith, an immigrant from Scotland. Smith had been a manufacturer of broadcloth in Fifeshire, Scotland. He continued that tradition here by establishing a woolen mill with slave labor on Smith Creek, for whom the creek was named. In 1837, Smith's sister Jean and her husband Andrew Williamson joined them from Scotland. Although married, Smith and his wife had no children, and after his death in 1857, his holdings were willed to his nephew David Williamson (also born in Scotland). The 1850 Census noted Henry Smith (age 61) as a farmer with a \$6,000 value in real estate. The area that he owned, land on both sides of the Jackson River and east of Smith Creek, came to be known as Williamson's. The 1860 census noted David Williamson (31) as a farmer with only a \$600 value in land, but it had substantially increased by 1870 to \$8,000.¹⁵

By 1800, many charcoal-fired furnaces were built across the Appalachians and especially in iron-ore rich Alleghany County. By the 1820s, several furnaces were established in the vicinity where the Jackson and Cowpasture Rivers converge to form the James (three miles east of Clifton Forge). In 1827, Scots-Irishman Col. John Jordan of Lexington, Virginia, and his business partner, John Irvine, and two of Jordan's sons purchased eight tracts of land in Alleghany, Bath, and Rockbridge counties totaling 26,143 acres.¹⁶ Colonel Jordan, who moved to Rockbridge County from Hanover County in 1802, had a "dynamic" personality and a zest for public investments and improvements. His career began with grist mill and weaving operations, construction of various public buildings, and eventually together with John Irvine (Jordan & Irvine) progressed to road construction and river (canal) improvements.¹⁷ It was a natural progression for the two to invest in the developing iron-making industry that would augment their transportation investments. Alleghany County (1822) at that time was ripe for development as it contained the perfect combination of rich iron ore deposits, vast forests for fuel (charcoal), water for power and transportation, and limestone.¹⁸

Included within Jordan & Irvine's initial land purchase was an 8,730-acre tract in Alleghany County where the Cowpasture and Jackson rivers meet to form the James River. Six miles east of present day Clifton Forge, on Simpson Creek, a tributary of the Cowpasture River, Jordan & Irvine established the Lucy Selina Furnace (named after their respective wives). The furnace was built in 1827 as a cold-blast, charcoal-fueled furnace, which was later redeveloped as the first coke-fired furnace in Virginia. The furnace, later renamed the Longdale Furnace under new ownership, operated until 1911. The furnace is listed on the NRHP as the Longdale Furnace Historic District, DHR ID 003-0338. In addition to the 1827 furnace, Jordan & Irvine built a corresponding ca. 1827 forge in the scenic Rainbow Gap of the Jackson River between present day Clifton Forge and Iron Gate. Also known as the Iron Gate Gorge, the arched seam of exposed ore on the west face of the river bank is one of the Commonwealth's most picturesque geological features. The forge was built on the south bank of the river

using massive blocks of rough-hewn rectangular limestone, which was typical construction of those built in Virginia's piedmont and mountainous areas. The forge was one of many small iron furnaces that used nearby ore, and was also allegedly operated by James Clifton and became known as the Clifton Forge.¹⁹

The ca. 1827 Clifton Forge was a tilt-hammer forge that produced pig iron bars. The products were easy to transport down the Jackson River to the James River and beyond to the shipping ports of Lynchburg, Petersburg, and Richmond. Using predominantly slave labor and the Jackson River water power, the forge also produced wrought-iron agricultural tools such as wagon wheels and plow shares that were sold or bartered to the early settlers. By 1831, the Clifton Forge consisted of the forge house with two hammers, another small forge with one hammer, a charcoal storage house, a sawmill, and a "manufactory" (gristmill).²⁰ The Clifton Forge continued to produce pig iron until the demand for wrought iron increased and the furnace went out of blast in 1854, and continued only on a limited basis until the entire operation ceased in 1877. Other cold-blast furnaces operated in Alleghany and Botetourt Counties before and during the Civil War, some of which, like the Lucy Selina Furnace, sent pig iron down the James River to the Tredegar Iron Works in Richmond, Virginia, to make Confederate cannons and cannon balls. However, after the Civil War, many furnaces ceased operations due to their natural inefficiency and the sudden lack of slave labor. The iron industry in Virginia was completely abandoned by World War I when more easily accessible iron ore was discovered in the Great Lakes region.

Jordan & Irvine's early 19th century land holdings consisted primarily of wilderness, which grew slowly, mostly with the influx of Scots-Irish immigrants from Pennsylvania. In 1822, as Virginia's economy was expanding, Alleghany County was established from parts of Botetourt and Bath counties, with the county seat established at Covington, ten miles west of present-day Clifton Forge. The county was named for the Allegheny Mountains, in which it lies.²¹ As the isolated communities grew, the need for transportation improvements increased.

In 1826, what began as a road over North Mountain connecting Lexington and Clifton Forge for Jordan's mining operations was incorporated as the Lexington and Covington Turnpike. This path roughly followed what was known as the old Midland Trail across Alleghany County, and created expansion in this area, which may have initiated the eventual establishment of Williamson's. The combined right-of-way of Route 60 and Interstate 64 currently carries traffic over the same route as did the Midland Trail and turnpike. Although efforts to canalize and improve the Jackson River were also planned, they were never implemented. In 1784, the James River and Kanawha Canal Company had incorporated with the intention to extend the navigation of the James River up the Jackson as far as Covington. However, the navigation of the James River only extended as far west as the Town of Buchanan in eastern Botetourt County. The initiation of the Virginia Central Railroad rendered the proposed plans for canalization on the Jackson River obsolete. The arrival of the Virginia Central coincided with the development of the Williamson's community on the north bank of the Jackson River.

In the middle to late 19th century, railroads were at the peak of their expansion and had a virtual monopoly over long distance transportation. Construction on the Virginia Central Railroad began in Richmond in 1840 and

reached Charlottesville in 1850. The Blue Ridge Mountains loomed in its path, and the states' chief engineer, Claudius Crozet, supervised the construction of the Blue Ridge Tunnel through the mountain. Completed in 1854, the tunnel was one of the longest in the world at that time. The railroad pushed on to Waynesboro by 1856, over North Mountain, down to Goshen, and finally arrived at the Jackson's River Station three miles west of the Williamson's settlement on July 10, 1857. The community became known as Jackson's River Depot (present-day Selma), and was located on the south bank of the Jackson River.

By the eve of the Civil War, the Jackson's River Depot included a depot, fuel and water facilities, a hotel, and a Presbyterian Church. The Oakland Grove Presbyterian Church (003-0004), a ca. 1847 Flemish bond brick church and the oldest church in Alleghany County, served not only the Scots-Irish Presbyterians, but all denomination in the environs. The first prominent families of the area, such as the Williamsons, are buried there. As the terminus of the Virginia Central, the Jackson's River Station was the transfer point for passengers disembarking from Richmond to stagecoaches for the healing spring resorts such as The Homestead and White Sulphur Springs and other points west. Just ten miles short of its destination at Covington, the completion of the railroad was delayed due to lack of funds and the outbreak of the Civil War. After the war, the Virginia Central rebuilt lines, bridges, and facilities, and by the late 1860s, a daily passenger train left Richmond for Staunton, and a tri-weekly train went to Jackson's River.²²

In 1869, the Virginia Central Railroad consolidated with the partially completed Covington & Ohio Railroad, and Collis P. Huntington, who was instrumental in expanding the Transcontinental Railroad, was enticed to help finance the venture. In 1873, the entire system was renamed the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway in order to reflect the railroad's mission to stretch from the Chesapeake Bay to the Ohio River. By the end of 1873, the railroad was completed to Huntington, West Virginia, and the banks of the Ohio River, where it stalled due to the economic depression of 1873-1878. And particularly, in 1873, the C&O relocated its depot from the 'Jackson's River Station' to the Williamsons community (east of Smith Creek). Additionally, in 1881, the Richmond & Alleghany railroad also arrived in Williamson's. They convinced the McCurdy family, who operated a hotel in Covington, to build a second hotel at Williamson's. The C&O also built a row of two-story workers housing known as 'tenements' close to the freight depot. Only the freight depot survives, and houses the privately owned C&O Railway Heritage Center. This early area of Williamson's is outside the boundary of the Clifton Forge Residential Historic District.

With two railroads now established at Williamson's, the divisional organization of the C&O was rearranged. Where Staunton had previously been the dividing point between the eastern and western divisions, now Williamsons was more centrally located between Richmond, Virginia, and the coal fields of Huntington, West Virginia, and was made the divisional point in 1878. By 1882, Williamson's boasted about 700 residents, mostly railroad workers for the C&O and the Richmond & Alleghany railroad. Anticipating a building boom,

David Williamson and neighboring landowners petitioned the General Assembly of Virginia to incorporate Williamson's as a town, and on December 1, 1884, Williamson's officially became the Town of Clifton Forge.²³

In 1889, the C&O reorganized under new leadership and new financial backing. The railroad bought out the Richmond & Alleghany, extended the line to Cincinnati, expanded their facilities, and built new ones. Clifton Forge was strategically located to receive the greatest economic impact from the railroad because it was a major intersection for three rail lines; the line up the mountain to Staunton, the line down the river to Richmond, and the line west over Allegheny Mountain to the coal fields of West Virginia. Larger facilities were needed, and in 1890, the C&O consolidated its shop facilities one mile west of the Clifton Forge depot in an area that became known as West Clifton Forge. This was the C&O's second largest shop and yard facility, specializing in repair with a capacity of 5,000 cars. The area in-between the depot and the shops was developed into the town's new commercial district. With two streams to bridge and gullies to cross, the town's growth followed the railroad, and in 1906, the two communities incorporated together as Clifton Forge.²⁴

The C&O bought about 1,200 acres of land for \$30,000 and established the C&O Development Corporation to sell the lots. Two hundred lots were sold by lottery on the auction days of September 2 and 3, 1890, for \$250,000. Speculators also bought and sold lots at a feverish pace. The town quickly grew and the railroad employed 3,000 people at its peak. The railroad paid well, which helped to established strong middle class neighborhoods. These parcels that were sold, and the streets and neighborhoods that subsequently developed, establish the significance of the historic district for listing under Criterion C for Community Planning and Development. With the east end of town already developed, the area between the shops and (west of) Smith Creek was filling in by 1896, and the emphasis of the town shifted back towards the middle and away from the west end of town. Between 1890 and 1900, the city's population more than doubled to 3,212. When West Clifton Forge was incorporated in 1900, the combined population was close to 5,200 (it was annexed by Clifton Forge in 1906).²⁵

Andrew Jackson (A.J.) Acord ideally settled in Clifton Forge in 1879 on the verge of the building boom, and quickly established himself as a building contractor. Born in Virginia, the 1880 census notes him as married with two children, and working as a carpenter at age 26. The 1888-1889 Chataigne's Directory notes him as a Lumber Dealer, the only such one in Clifton Forge. And by 1892, the Sanborn Insurance Map denoted his lumber yard and planning mill operation at Church Street and Smith Creek (105-0186). Being fully established, Acord capitalized on the C&O's residential development by building 183 houses in Clifton Forge between 1879 and 1894, some of which may have been commercial buildings.²⁶

The new railroad shops were completed and opened on May 1, 1891, and by late 1893 were employing 300 men repairing 50 freight cars daily. The facilities expanded and improved in 1896, 1903, and 1907. The roundhouse was enlarged in 1911 and in 1912 the shops were converted from steam power to electric. World War I

increased the demand on the shops, and by late 1920, a new 10-stall engine house, a power plant, storehouse, as well as other facilities were built. The success of the C&O also spurred construction in the town, both with their own facilities and encouraging new civic improvements. In the first decade of the 20th century, Clifton Forge enjoyed a new municipal water works, wood, iron, and stone bridges built across the ravines and creeks of the neighborhoods, a small power plant that furnished electricity, the paving of streets and sidewalks, and a new post office, and a town hall. Further, commercial as well as professional businesses, churches, banks, and homes continued to be built well into the first quarter of the 20th century.²⁷

Although Clifton Forge was predominately a white, middle class town, African Americans played an important role. By the turn of the 20th century, approximately 1,000 African Americans lived in Clifton Forge, comprising about one-third of the population. With the annexation of the mostly white West Clifton Forge in 1900, blacks accounted for about one-fifth of the 5,200 residents. Of the 948 households recorded in the 1914 city directory, 128 were African American, many of whom worked for the railroad.²⁸ The historically black area of Clifton Forge, which also included the south side of the river, predominately followed on the north side of the river and on the east side of town, along Main, Church and Pine streets. African American businessmen and professionals, such as doctors, ministers, educators, and morticians, served this community. For example, both Dr. Edward T. Conner and Dr. S. G. Gibbs lived and practiced on Church Street in the 1920s. Two original Baptist churches continue to serve the community, the ca. 1892 brick-veneered First Baptist Church on Church Street and the 1921, brick, Gothic Revival-style Main Street Baptist Church that replaced the original 1885 frame church (originally for the white congregation).²⁹

Edmund F. Scott was one of the most successful businessmen in Clifton Forge, white or black, and broke racial barriers as a black man owning and operating a hotel at 411-413 Ridgeway Street (located in the NRHP-listed Clifton Forge Commercial Historic District, DHR ID 105-0017, 1992). This three-story frame commercial building downtown is being renovated for a bed and breakfast inn. Scott operated the ca. 1900 hotel (built prior to 1907), and the restaurant within it, and a barber shop that was located in the adjacent hotel addition (added between 1907 and 1913). Scott is noted in the 1900 census (age 41) as a Saloon Keeper and in the 1920 Census as a Proprietor.³⁰ Edmund F. Scott arrived in Clifton Forge in 1881 and operated orchards north of the town (he also grew wheat and corn). In 1882, he married Bettie L. Scott and they had two daughters and two sons. He also had a live-in black servant. By 1889, he had sold over 300 acres of land and began investing in real estate both in Clifton Forge and Covington. He lived in the large Queen Anne house overlooking 900 Church Street, and owned parcels of land, some of which he donated for the First Baptist Church on Church Street.³¹

By the late 1920s, Clifton Forge boasted 6,800 residents, 16 daily passenger trains, a bustling downtown, and a strong school system. The two main high schools at this time were the 1928 Clifton Forge High School (white), and the 1926 Jefferson High School (black). Known as Jefferson School, it was listed on the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Education and Black Ethnic Heritage for its close association with the history of Clifton Forge and its African American community for almost forty years.³² In 1939, the population reached

nearly 7,000 people with 1,500 dwellings. The town reached the eve of World War II with full optimism for a strong economic future, and the C&O shops continued to employ 1,200 people. However, after World War II, and across America, the railroads began converting from steam-powered locomotives to diesel-powered locomotives. Diesel engines were used during the war to power submarines and this innovative design was transitioned into powering locomotives after the war. Many of the railroads embraced this new technology as it brought with it a new sleek, modern design in order to capture America's heart and to continue riding the rails. Although the conversion to diesel required new shops, their long-term benefits outweighed the cost of maintaining the steam locomotives. Diesels also spent far less time in the shops and more time on the rails transporting freight and passengers and thereby reaping greater profits.³³

While other railroads across America converted to diesel, the C&O, as well as the Norfolk & Western Railway, headquartered in Roanoke, Virginia, were the last railroads to convert from steam power; with the C&O ordering a new steam locomotive as late as 1948. When the first diesel locomotive finally reached Clifton Forge in 1950, the need for their massive maintenance shops declined. In 1953, the shops were converted to diesel maintenance, and the C&O's last steam locomotives were abandoned by 1956. The post-World War II prosperity that hastened the popularity of the automobile and the emergence of the interstate highway system (with freight now delivered by trucks) and commercial airlines augmented the decline of all rail shops and stations across American. The C&O Railway shops eventually moved to West Virginia when employment numbers steadily fell, and permanently closed in 1987.³⁴

The C&O became part of the mega-railroad system, CSX, which operates a major locomotive fuel facility in Clifton Forge. Amtrak, the national passenger rail service, also provides service to the Clifton Forge Passenger Station with the Cardinal Route three days a week. The C&O Historical Society, which re-located to Clifton Forge in 1986 from West Virginia, owns the former Clifton Forge Freight Station, which now serves as the C&O Railway Heritage Center, within the NRHP-listed Clifton Forge Commercial Historic District (1992).³⁵

Although the population has declined, the Town of Clifton Forge is experiencing a renaissance. The community and town government are deeply dedicated and civic-minded with an already established commercial historic district and an Architectural Review Board that oversees it. Downtown businesses are returning and new residents are moving into the traditional historic neighborhoods. The buildings and settings of the historic district strongly denote the architectural character of the town's 1890 development that was directly associated with the establishment of the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway in Clifton Forge. The early layout of the streets and alleys that was based on the Towns' 1890 plat map remains predominate amid mature landscaping and negligible modern infill. The abundance and variety of architectural styles, including residential kit houses, and architect-designed churches and schools, in both the black and white communities, are clear reminders of its early heritage as a boom town connected to the emergence of the railroad system across America. The presence of the railroad, the Jackson River, the base of a forested hill, remains the unchanged background for this railroad town that prospered from 1890 to 1950.
