The Thomas Harrison House is an example of eighteenth century Shenandoah Valley vernacular architecture. The city of Harrisonburg has grown around the house and it is now used as offices. An unusual feature of the house is its gable entrance, now obscured by later construction.

The slightly rectangular dwelling is two-bays wide, one-bay deep and one-and-a-half stories high. The house originally had a full English basement. but this has been partially covered because of a raise in grade level. The foundations and walls are in coursed rubble limestone with well-defined flat arches over the windows. Apparently a two-level porch originally sheltered the east gable end and also provided passage between the first and second floors as there appears to have been no interior staircase. This porch has since disappeared and the building is now connected to a nineteenth century brick structure by means of a wide stone passage. An interior chimney with a brick stack rises off-center from the west gable. The window and door architraves are carved from solid lengths of pine. Double-hung sash in the north and south sides has six-over-six light; in the west gable end the sash is four-over-four on the lower floor and early nineteenth century two-overtwo on the upper floor. An original batten door with strap hinges opens into the basement. The gable roof has a molded wooden box cornice with short returns. One gabled dormer is in the north slope and two are on the south slope.

The interior plan features two rectangular rooms on the first floor with a single room in the basement and on the second floor. The present stair is in the later connecting passage. The basement is entered by a door in the north side. Where modern panelling has not been installed, the walls are painted plaster. The first floor rooms have a molded chair rail and corner fireplaces, one of which has a distinguished vernacular mantel with a floral motif. This mantle is a replacement and was originally in the larger brick house attached to the front. The remaining mantels have simple molded shelves.

The house was built over a spring, which is accessible in the basement, although the water flows on underground to nearby Black's Run. The house also was connected by tunnel to another spring, Head Spring, on Court Square. The tunnel was closed in 1910.

The Thomas Harrison House is the oldest house in Harrisonburg, and its builder is regarded as the town's founder. Thomas Harrison owned over a thousand acres surrounding the house, and on this tract he laid out the original town. He also was instrumental in having Harrisonburg established as the county seat of Rockingham County in 1780.

Thomas Harrison was the son of Isaiah and Abigail Harrison, descending from a family of English extraction who had settled on Long Island in New York around 1688. The family later moved to Delaware before finally coming to Rockingham County, Virginia around 1738. Thomas Harrison became a major landowner in the county, eventually acquiring 2100 acres. He built the present house about 1750, and it remained in the Harrison family until 1870.

The Harrison House was the scene of the first courts held in Harrisonburg after it became the county seat. Bishop Asbury, the pioneer leader of the Methodist-Episcopal Church, often visited Harrison and conducted some of the first Methodist services held in the county in the house. In 1794 a Methodist-Episcopal conference was held in the Harrison's house.

In addition to its historical associations, the Thomas Harrison House is interesting as an example of a mid-eighteenth century rural house which early in its history became part of an urban center. As one of the Valley of Virginia's oldest examples of stone vernacular construction, the house is a rare architectural survival.
