STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

With its powerful Greek Doric courthouse and its Confederate monument, the courthouse square in Lawrenceville is the epitome of the nineteenthcentury Virginia shire town. The small group of public buildings forms a harmonious ensemble which acts as a focal point for the life of the village. Through fortunate ties of Masonic fraternity between E. R. Turnbull, the county clerk and builder of the courthouse, and a Union raider, the Brunswick records were spared the destruction which befell so many governmental records during the Civil War.

Brunswick County, named for the Duchy of Brunswick, home of the English royal House of Hanover, was established by an act of the General Assembly in 1720, although its bounds were not drawn until 1723. The county had been set up as a buffer against anticipated French and Indian attacks, but actually had few settlers until after the famous survey of the dividing line between Virginia and North Carolina, described by William Byrd II in 1728. No courthouse was needed, then, until 1732, when the first one was built. Brunswick County at this period was 230 miles long, and the courthouse was moved in 1744 and again in 1783 to compensate for the periodic setting off of large areas as new counties. In 1814,000 Lawrenceville was established around the courthouse, by legislative act, to be the county seat. By 1853, a new courthouse was needed, and a committee was appointed to inspect and presumably to copy the 1842 Mecklenburg County Courthouse at Boydton. A contract was let to E. R. Turnbull and Robert Kirkland, who built a courthouse for \$7000 which, however, bore little resemblance to the Boydton building. In 1893 separate facilities were provided for the clerk's office.
