

<u>Inventory Examples for Register Nominations</u>

History Districts

A nomination for listing a historic district in the Virginia Landmarks Register and National Register of Historic Places must include an inventory of all the contributing and non-contributing resources within the historic boundaries. The National Park Service (NPS) and Virginia Department of Historic Resources (DHR) accept two formats for inventories. The first format creates a basic inventory entry that includes a property's address, DHR number, primary resources and its number of stories, style, and construction date. Any secondary resources also should be included in the entry. The second format includes this information as well as a narrative description of the resource. Examples of each format are below. Inventories are placed in Section 7 of the nomination form.

Automatically Generated Inventories

For historic district nominations, the Virginia Cultural Resource Information System (VCRIS) must be used to generate historic district inventories. Users can create an automatically generated report after completing entry of architectural survey data for a historic district.*

*Please note that completion of data entry is *required* before a historic district nomination can be presented to Virginia's State Review Board and Board of Historic Resources.

The original dwelling was a 1 1/2-story, side hall, frame building that was enlarged in the late nineteenth century. A two-story, front gable wing was added to the north side of the house around 1840 and in 1890, a two-story bay was added to the front of the wing. Around the mid-twentieth century, the house was clad with stucco.

Individually Nominated Property

Nominations for individual properties also should include a brief inventory if the property has more than a single resource. However, unlike a historic district, for an individually nominated property each resource must be described as well as being included in the inventory. The inventory can be presented before or after the entire narrative description in Section 7, or a narrative description can immediately follow each inventory entry.

The inventory may be manually created or VCRIS can be used to generate the inventory. Either way, the inventory should list every resource associated with the property, its resource type (building, structure, site, or object), its construction date, and its status as either contributing or non-contributing. A brief explanation of how the non-contributing status was assigned also should be provided.

Example of an Inventory for an Individually Nominated Property with Multiple Resources:

Inventory of Contributing and Non-Contributing Resources

(All non-contributing resources postdate the period of significance for Rockfalls.)

- 1. Rockfalls, primary residence, 1936-1937, contributing building
- 2. Yard Stone Wall, landscape feature, 1936-1937, contributing object
- 3. Entrance Road Bed with bridge, vehicular road, 1936-1937, contributing structure
- 4. Steel Post Border Fencing, landscape feature, 1936-1937, contributing object
- 5. Corner Boulder Tunnel, rock structure, 1970s, non-contributing structure
- 6. Road Corner Wall, rock structure, 1970s, non-contributing structure
- 7. Unfinished Boulder Structure, rock structure, 1980s, non-contributing structure
- 8. Unfinished Boulder "Church", rock structure, 1990s, non-contributing structure
- 9. Man-made Island, found-materials structure, 1980s, non-contributing structure
- 10. Arrow Sculpture Assemblage, found materials object, 1980s, non-contributing, object
- 11. Raised Brick Square, brick landscape structure, 1980s, non-contributing structure
- 12. Berms, earthen structure, 1980s, non-contributing structure
