In July 2020, the Commission for Historical Statues in the United States Capitol unanimously recommended that the statue of General Robert E. Lee, currently located in the National Statua Hall Collection at the United States Capitol, be replaced.

The Commission invited recommendations for a replacement statue, of a prominent Virginia citizen of historic renown, or renowned for distinguished civil or military service, to be made to the Virginia General Assembly for commemoration in the National Statuary Hall Collection. This official recommendation period concluded on 11/27/20; however, your feedback still counts!

The Pocahontas Project recommends that the Commonwealth of Virginia replace the statue of Robert E. Lee in the US Capitol with a statue of the woman born Matoaka, who died Rebecca, ai who was most famously known as Pocahontas.

The Project suggests that Pocahontas should be considered "America's Founding Mother" because her actions facilitated and enabled a series of events that led to the development of tl original Thirteen Colonies and, ultimately, the United States of America.

The Project further suggests that Pocahontas' religious conversion and marriage to John Rolfe brought an important time of peace between the Powhatan People and the English, and that he subsequent journey to England hardened British resolve to continue its support of the Virginia Company and begin other efforts directed at colonizing America. The Pocahontas Project believes that Pocahontas is worthy of a statue in the United States Capitol. The newly-formed Thirteen Colonies ultimately embraced the Powhatans' model of representative government and the concept of freedom to rule. The Powhatan People, and especially Pocahontas, played an important early role in the development of the new American nation by teaching John Rolfe how to grow tobacco and draft the seeds he took from the islanc with the wild Virginia tobacco, giving the English settlers a cash crop needed for survival.

The Project believes that without Pocahontas' hopeful and purposeful action, no individual currently recognized in the U.S. Capitol would have achieved their place in history. The Project believes it is appropriate that the two statues in the United States Capitol, from the Commonwealth of Virginia, represent (1) George Washington, one of America's Founding Fathers; and (2) Pocahontas, one of America's Founding Mothers.
