Virtual Meeting Policy

COMMISSION ON HISTORICAL STATUES IN THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL

ELECTRONIC MEETINGS HELD UNDER 2.2-3708.3 OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA

Remote Participation by the Entire Body

- A. It is the policy of the Commission that it may hold all virtual public meetings pursuant to subsection C of 2.2-3708.3.
- B. Requests for remote participation or that the Commission conduct an all-virtual public meeting shall be conveyed to staff to the Board who shall then relay such requests to the chair of the public body.
- C. Such all-virtual public meetings are also limited by law to two meetings per calendar year or 25 percent of the meetings held per calendar year rounded up to the next whole number, whichever is greater.
- D. An all-virtual public meeting may not be held consecutively with another all-virtual public meeting.

- Books with titles




Next Steps
